

Absen screens 'just work' for Empower Church



Empower Church is a multi-cultural, dynamic, modern and effective Church based in Pretoria. Since the COVID-19 pandemic, the church has experienced remarkable growth and has recently acquired Absen KL2.5 panels from DWR Distribution to continue expanding its online presence.

For an extended time, they hired an Absen screen from the technical supply company Stage Effects but eventually decided to purchase their own panels.

The KL Series has been designed for permanent installations, delivering vibrant colours, high refresh rate, high contrast ratio and high grayscale. The new panels were given a frame, designed and manufactured by DWR's Keith Pugin, and then integrated into the church's existing LED support structure.

The result is an ideal backdrop for preaching, providing backlight and colour wash during worship, and enhancing the stage decor. It collaborates with the lights and is also used to help set the mood and atmosphere in the auditorium. The designers and the media team work hand in hand to ensure creative content, motion backgrounds, updated themes and videos that 'pop', which they describe as an ideal solution for a modern-day church environment.

The church's technical team are mostly volunteers, with only a few full-time staff. Thanks to Absen's ease of use, volunteers never have to think about the technicalities of sending a signal or managing the screen.
