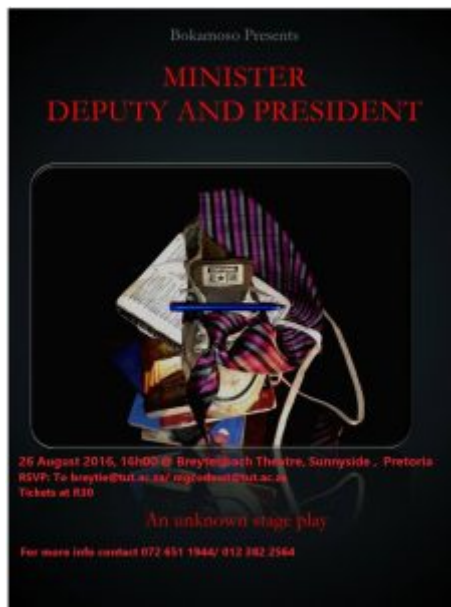
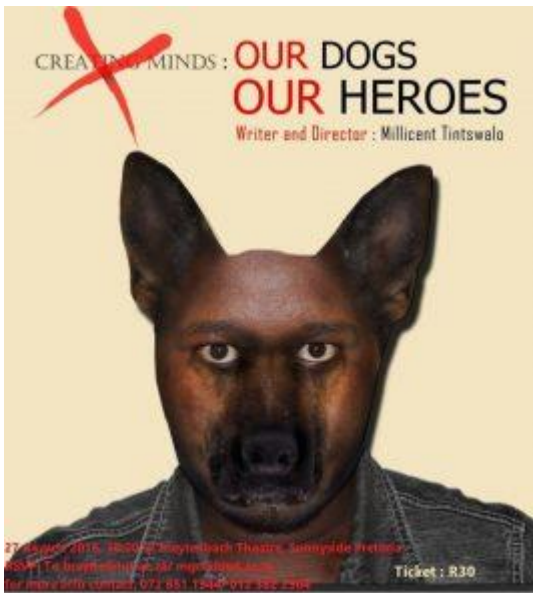


The festival was the brainchild of Hardus Koekemoer, Lighting Lecturer at the TUT's Department of Entertainment, who then developed the idea with Wandile Mgcodo, Technical Head at the Breytenbach Theatre. "We have had great support from our working committee, including the Entertainment of Technology Department and our partners, DWR Distribution and the City of Tshwane," commented Wandile. "The initial concept was to create a forum where our students could interact with outside practitioners, which creates a bigger room for learning."



This year the festival saw an increase in terms of productions where four new community theatre groups participated. "The attendance was great," he said. "Some of the productions which showcased included *Tselane and the Giant*; *Crying over Spilt Milk*; *Mmatswale*; *The Diary*;
