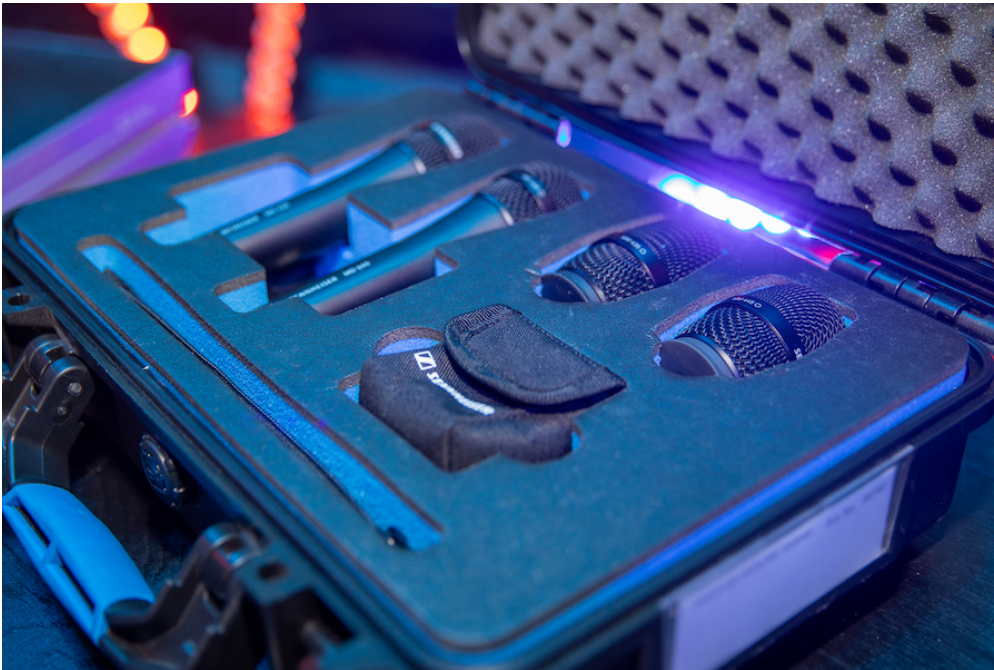
DWR's offices in Johannesburg and Cape Town, while the Durban leg was kindly hosted by the Grace Family Church.



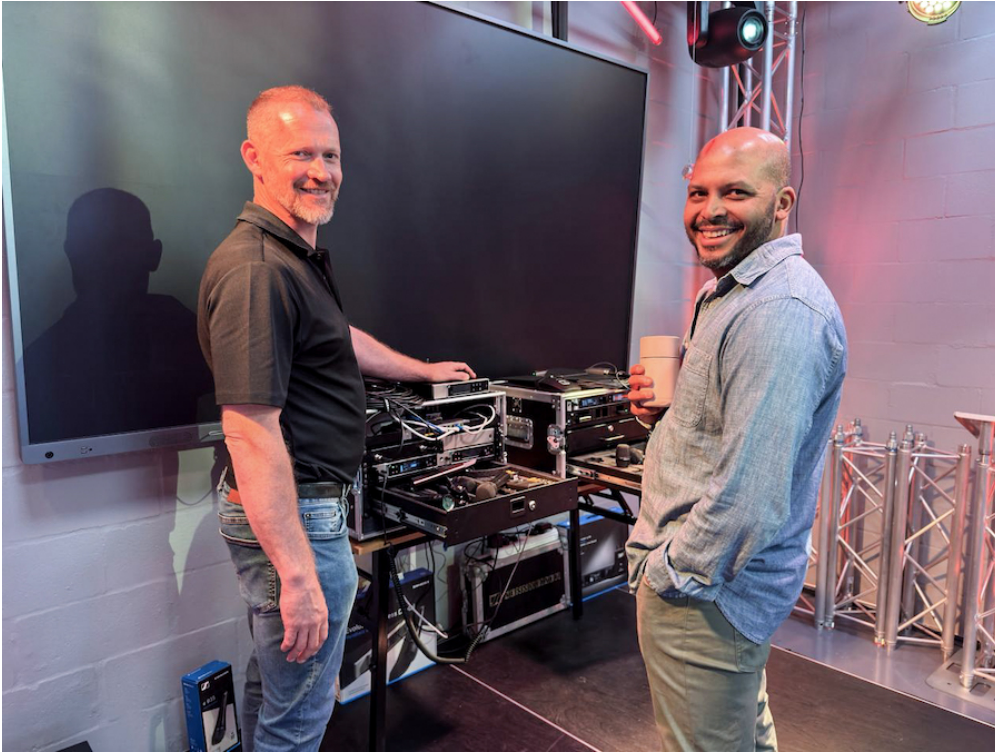
