Control was on a grandMA and the range of lighting fixtures included of 12 Clay Paky Sharpy, 12 Robe Pointes, 12 Robin 100 LEDBeam, 12 Robin 1000, 8 Martin MAC 401, 8 MAC 2000, 24 Par 63, 8 Source Fours, 16 LED Parcans and Avolites Dimmers.





EPH'S Leon Pheiffer was proud of his team and mentioned them by name. "Danie Janse van Rensburg was Production Manager and also ran the show from the Stage Managers Desk, Murray Lubbe was on FOH, Jacques du Toit, Jonathan Velleman, Johannes Mololekoa on stage and Gabriel le Roux on monitors," he says. "We had Johan Ferreira with Andre Westraad on lighting. JP Prinsloo handled the AV for all the screens with the Watchout System."

EPH also supplied the sound and screens.
