


JHB International Motor Show

Client: Jaguar Land Rover South Africa


Spec: Clean cut, slick lighting and nicely lit across the floor.

Did you hire in any of the gear and from which company? Eventech (Trussing)


What trussing did you use: T.F.L.

The most difficult challenge was that were not able to complete the entire installation at once, but had to go back in stages.






What were your Highlights:


The design spec / rendering of the Volvo stand


Did you hire in any of the gear and if so, from whom? Yes Power Pars, not telling


What trussing (brand) did you utilize? Milos, Prolyte
