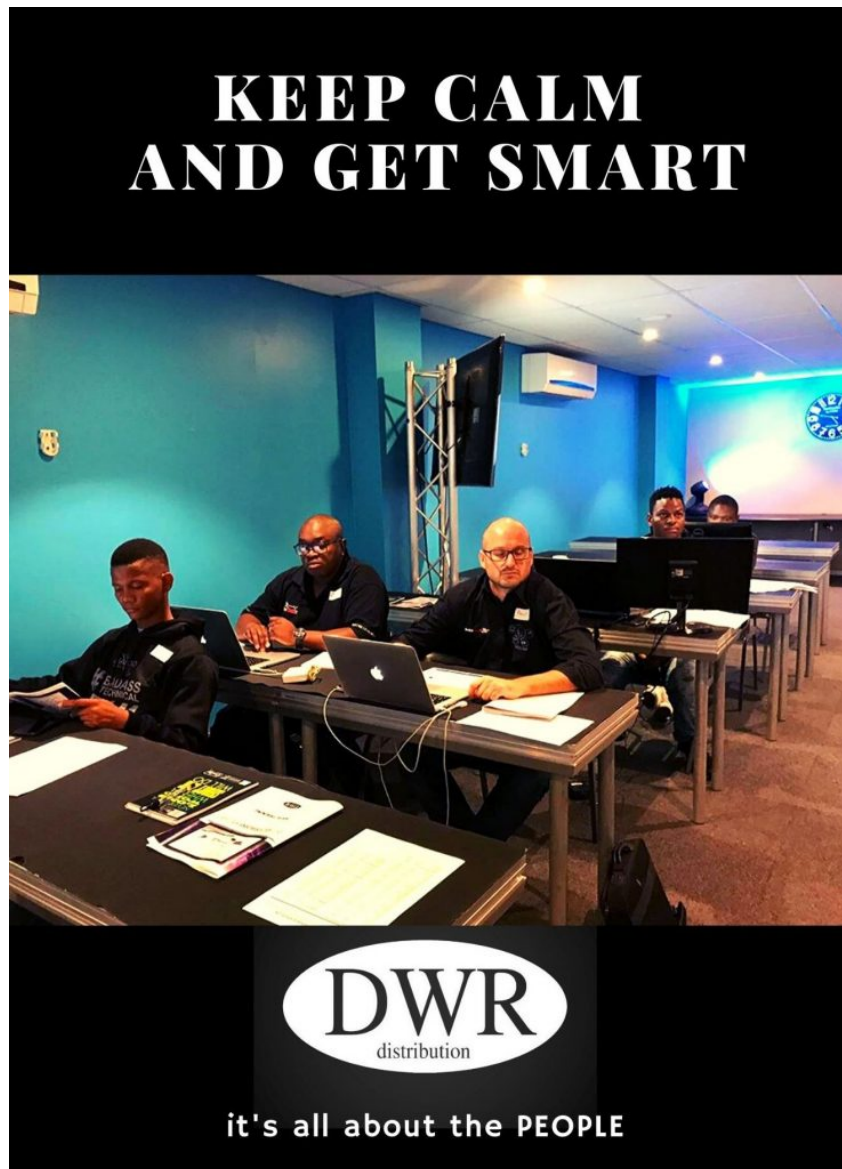


KEEP CALM AND GET SMARTER
