
"Proudly we rode with DWR by our side!" said Dillon, who sent in these great pics of the 3 day stage race.

Ride the Rhino is a three day stage event, covering an estimated 300 kilometres. The main beneficiary is the Renosterveld Trust, followed by the improvement of communities along the route such as the !Khwa Ttu San Foundation, Malmesbury schools, Camphill Village, Ons Nessie Outreach Foundation and Groeneweide Old Age Home.
